It is especially grievous to witness elements within the established denominations aligning with secular ideologies—including uncritical endorsement of the LGBTQ+ agenda and a growing accommodation of Islam—stances that are now echoed at both governmental levels and within the Monarchy.

This nation, once proudly founded upon Christian principles, is experiencing a spiritual decline on many fronts. Yet, in the face of these challenges, the calling and mission of this ministry remain unwavering. We are deeply thankful that the Lord continues to bless our efforts and sustain our outreach in miraculous ways. All glory to God!

A heartfelt thank you to all of our dedicated teams across the UK. I give thanks to God for each one of you who, with unwavering commitment, go out week after week, often braving harsh weather and enduring ridicule, mockery, and even hostility. Your perseverance is a testament to the power of the Gospel and the faithfulness of our Lord.

And yet, we are called to love them all—even those who oppose us. We strive to reflect Christ's compassion in all our interactions, praying that hearts would be softened and lives transformed.

We are also grateful for the encouragers the Lord sends our way—especially our beloved prayer warriors. Your intercession is the unseen backbone of this work, and we praise God for your faithfulness.

We are pleased to share that we now have a board of five Trustees overseeing our newly established charitable status.
